

PART 1 - INTRODUCTORY PROVISIONS

Short Title

- 1.1 This regulation may be cited as the Freedom of Information Fees Amendment Regulation.

Application

- 1.2 This regulation establishes
- (a) the prescribed portion of the estimated fee under section 2.12(a) of the Act, and
 - (b) the prescribed times that portion of the estimated fee under section 2.12(a) of the Act must be paid.

Definitions

- 1.3 In this regulation:

“Act” means the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, YFNS 11/2011;

“Regulation” means the Freedom of Information Forms and Fees Regulation, YFNR 35/2016.

PART 2 - AMENDMENTS

Prescribed matters

- 2.1 Section 2.2 of the Regulation is amended by adding the following subsections immediately following section 2.2(c):
- “(d) The prescribed portion of the estimated fee under section 2.12(a) of the Act is 66 per cent of the applicable application fee and other fees calculated in accordance with subsection (a).
 - (e) The prescribed times at which the prescribed portion of the estimated fee under section 2.12(a) of the Act must be paid are,
 - (i) within 30 days of the notice under subsection (b) being delivered to the applicant, if the portion of the estimated fee under subsection (d) is less than \$1000, or
 - (ii) within 60 days of the notice under subsection (b) being delivered to the applicant, if the portion of the estimated fee under subsection (d) is \$1000 or greater.
 - (f) An applicant that does not pay the estimated fee in the applicable amount or at the applicable times in accordance with this section is deemed to have withdrawn their request under section 2.2 of the Act.”

Retroactive effect

- 2.2 Section 2.2 is deemed to have come into force on October 20, 2016 and is retroactive to the extent necessary to give it effect on and after that date.
